

TRIBUTE TO DATO' N.J. RYAN



ALL ABOUT RYAN

An age-old Malay proverb came to life at a Catholic funeral in Melbourne last Thursday.

This discerning folk line about the value of a person's legacy was cited in thick, unadulterated Bahasa Melayu towards the end of the eulogy for headmaster Neil Ryan who once taught in Malaysia.

The event broke rigid traditions that could only come with the passing of someone so dear.

In fact, Ryan's funeral cut across at least three stiff boundaries -- geographical, language and, most significantly, religious.

Ryan, Irish by birth, died in Australia on April 22, 2011, many years after a legendary stint as a teacher in British Malaya.

And at the profound religious funeral at St Bede's Catholic Church, North Balwyn, Melbourne, it turned out that a Malay Muslim Malaysian, who had come all the way from Kuala Lumpur, was the one who delivered the eulogy, throwing in a Bahasa Melayu line as he spoke.

I managed to listen to a recording of the eulogy and it was so heartwarming -- a bit like the Lennonism pitch about the brotherhood of man.

"Harimau mati meninggalkan belang, manusia mati meninggalkan nama," said Datuk Khalilur Rahman Ibrahim as he concluded his seven-minute tribute to his mentor, translating the line to his awestruck mostly-Australian audience as "when a tiger dies, it leaves behind its stripes. When a man dies, he leaves behind his legacy".

Khalilur, a 62-year-old entrepreneur, was a quiet, diminutive student at the Malay College Kuala Kangsar when Ryan was headmaster in the early 1960s.

"He will always be our headmaster," he told the 200-odd people who came to pay their last respects.



This Muslim man, of all people, was the spokesman at the church funeral.

But knowing Ryan and his affinity with MCKK long after he retired, surely the former teacher couldn't have asked for more.

The funeral, according to Khalilur, was in the presence of Ryan's wife Josephine, his sons Brandon and Kevin, daughter-in-law Eithne, granddaughter Moya and about 200 close friends.

MCKK and its old boys (MCOBA), he added, were represented by several people, including Syed Abu Bakar Syed Salim, a fancy-free former art teacher well-liked by everyone.

What was perhaps most unmistakable about the kindred spirit was that Ryan, too, wore

the conspicuous MCKK tie in the casket, as the college meant so much to him, according to his wife Josephine.

In his will, Ryan bequeathed his sizeable book collection to the MCKK library.

2in (127cm) First Former and he was the 6ft 4in (193cm) headmaster.

"He had a Jaguar. He was a very humble and passionate man dedicated to his students.

"There are a few of us (from the school) here to honour this man. To share the grief with his family.

"I have always considered him my headmaster. We called him Mr Ryan. We liked him for all the right reasons. He was such a dedicated headmaster. I remember him most for his humour.

"There was one occasion when we were in class. There was a lot of noise and Mr Ryan walked in, asking what was going on.

"We told him we had no teacher as he had yet to come in. Then he asked us who the teacher was and we told him it was Syed Bakar.

"Mr Ryan said if the mountain couldn't come

about Ryan's passion for Jaguar cars.

"It was one of the most beautiful cars then. I once asked him whether I could drive the car.

"He brushed me off until his last day in office in MCKK (in 1965) when he came over with the car keys dangling from his hand and asked me whether I wanted to drive his car.

"I was the only student ever to drive Mr Ryan's Jaguar.

"The same Jaguar was kept in its original condition until more than 30 years later here in Australia. It showed his passion and it reflected the man.

"Mr Ryan, we wish and pray that you will have eternal happiness. We will always remember you. It is like the Malay saying harimau mati meninggalkan belang, manusia mati meninggalkan nama."

In a church funeral far from Malaysia, that sentence certainly rang out loud.

"Only as high as I reach can I grow, only as far as I seek can I go, only as deep as I look can I see, only as much as I dream can I be."

"I delivered the eulogy and spoke about the man we knew and loved, his wisdom, dedication, sense of humour and his contribution to our nation," said Khalilur.

That was some eulogy that I heard on tape. In front of a church crowd, it managed to capture the very essence of Ryan and MCKK, including Ryan's love for his Jaguar Mark 2.

Khalilur began the eulogy thus: "I was 13 years old when I went to the school as a 4ft

to Muhammad, Muhammad must come to the mountain.

"And what he did was get all 30 students to Syed Bakar's house to have the class conducted there.

"Syed Bakar is with us today. He was the school's art teacher and a close colleague of Mr Ryan."

Among other things, Khalilur also spoke



The MCKK Rugby 7's trophy is one of a kind. It embodies the spirit of the game that is filled with speed and competitiveness. This gentlemen's game has always been inaccurately portrayed as rough when it is actually a spirited, tactical, powerful, smart and even a graceful game.

The design for this trophy is simple yet powerful. The elements portray the speed of a fast turning rugby ball. It is a dynamic representation of the game. MALAY COLLEGE KUALA KANGSAR



<u>THE MALAY COLLEGE</u> Kuala Kangsar



The Malay College Kuala Kangsar (MCKK) is the first fully residential school in Malaysia. Its formation was proposed by the then Sultan of Perak, Sultan Idris Murshidul 'Adzam Shah I, and by Mr. R. J. Wilkinson, then Inspector of Schools for the Federated Malay States. The motion was supported by the three other Rulers of the Federated Malay States namely Sultan Alaiddin Sulaiman Shah of Selangor, Yam Tuan Tuanku Muhammad Shah of Negeri Sembilan and Sultan Ahmad Mu'adzam Shah of Pahang.

Established on 2nd January 1905, it was originally known as the **Malay Residential School of Kuala Kangsar.** In recognition of its founder figures, the Sport Houses take the name of the founders: Idris (white), Sulaiman (red), Ahmad (black), and Mohd Shah (yellow).

Mr W. Hargreaves was appointed as the first headmaster to lead the establishment of the school which operated from a number of wooden houses. The impressive central Greco-Roman structure that is fondly referred to as the Big School was only completed and officially opened by the Sultan of Perak on 11th December 1909. The auspicious date also marked the change in the name of the school from the Malay Residential School of Kuala Kangsar to the **Malay College of Kuala Kangsar**. The present principal, Mr. Anand Baharuddin, is the 23rd college head since its establishment.

Initially the school was founded to educate the Malay elite – royal children and the sons of Malay nobility. Few of its early students were from amongst commoner families. This changed dramatically after 1947, when qualified Malay boys aged from 12 to 17 from all around the country are being educated here. MCKK prides itself on having produced a steady stream of leaders such as kings, sultans, prime ministers, ministers as well as senior officials in the government and leading figures in the private sector who have contributed towards the growth and progress of the nation. Since its inception, more than 7,000 boys (and interestingly 2 girls, too) have entered the gates of MCKK.

The college celebrated its centenary on 26th March 2005, attended by The Yang di-Pertuan Agong, Royal Rulers, dignitaries, old boys, and townspeople. Over the years, MCKK has also received a number of foreign Heads of States and diplomats to its humble grounds.

MCKK has recorded many firsts in its illustrious history and is noted for its capacity in successfully staging large-scale programmes and events at the national level. Last year, MCKK embarked on organising the grandest school-level invitational rugby tournament with international participation. The success of the first MCKK Rugby Premier 7s in 2011, where teams battled to win the NJ. Ryan Trophy (named after the 9th headmaster of MCKK) has added this tournament as another piece of tradition of this college.

THE FOUNDATION

The MCKK Foundation was established to provide financial and technical support for the overall improvement to The MCKK. The year 2011 saw some of the initiatives undertaken by The MCKK Foundation progressively taking shape. The success is through the combined efforts of the financial contributors, alumni, teachers and students.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB)

The RM 10 million International Baccalaureate building complex, comprising classrooms, administrative offices, hostels and other facilities, was fully completed and delivered to The MCKK in April 2011.

The pioneer cohort of 18 students started their IB education in July 2011. The students are housed in the new complex equipped with modern facilities. They are taught by top rate academic staff that will make the MCKK IB Diploma Programme the preeminent and preferred institution to pursue the IB Diploma. It is planned that the 2012 intake in July would be about 60 students.

The IB Diploma offers a comprehensive and balanced curriculum and assessment system. Other than academic pursuit, in 2011 the students were involved in community service efforts like providing educational motivation to secondary school and leading or participating in community projects within the Kuala Kangsar vicinty. The students were also involved in the Peace day initiative at The Malay College Kuala Kangsar.

A plan is underway to organize an International Peace Day Conference in 2012. Work is also ongoing to produce a Kuala Kangsar Heritage Trail guide, targeted to be launched in conjunction with the birthday celebrations of DYMM Sultan of Perak birthday in April 2012.

TUN ABDUL RAZAK AUDITORIUM

The building of the RM8 million, auditorium started in January 2011. The auditorium is situated where the Industrial Art blocks and Tun Abdul Razak lecture theatre was before, in between the Prep School and the classroom block. Its forecourt will be marked by an open plaza that can accommodate various assembly and outdoor functions.

The auditorium is designed as a performing arts hall with a thrust stage; it provides an opportunity for both, performers and the audience to interact in an intimate setting. It would be equipped with state-of-the-art audio visual facilities. The auditorium would eventually encourage the development as well as the appreciation of performing arts and creative projects among students.

As of January 2012 the project is 82% complete, with expected commission by March 2012.

THE MALAY COLLEGE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT SUMMIT (MCYDS) 2011

The MCYDS is an annual programme initiated in 2008, aimed building character and values among students and helping them develop competitive perspectives and outlooks.

The MCYDS 2011 was held in June. Sixty delegates from various schools internationally attended the summit. The theme of this year's summit is 'What Works Well'. The delegates presented and exchanged ideas of what works well for their school. Highlights of the summit include:

- Dinner at the Istana Iskandariah hosted by DYTM Dr Raja Nazrin Shah, the Regent of Perak and the Chairman of the MCKK Board of Governors.
- Two day trip to Pangkor island for



environmental awareness and community service.

- Delegates witnessing the MCKK Speech Day.
- Dialogue with YB Dato Saifuddin Abdullah on Role of Youth in Society.
- Workshops and debates by delegates.
- Cultural performances by delegates.

MOUS WITH OTHER FOUNDATIONS AND HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTES

The MCKK Foundation has begun discussions with other foundations, corporations and higher education institutes to promote cooperation for the benefit of MCKK and its students as a whole.

We expect an interesting year in 2012 with new initiatives, collaborations and activities coming on stream.

<u>MCOBA:</u> <u>Strengthening old</u> School ties

On the morning of 16th March 1929, the little town of Kuala Kangsar awoke to a steady stream of motor-vehicles making their way though its shady lanes. The Old Boys were coming home. In total some 150 Old Boys converged on their alma mater that day. It was a day to pay homage to the place that had seen them though their boyhood and forged them into men, it was also the day the Malay College Old Boys Association (MCOBA) was formed with Raja Musa bin Raja Bhot elected as its founder president.

Over the years nothing seems to have slowed the MCKK Old Boys. Their loyalty and desire to participate the growth and development of the school and play a pivotal role in nurturing the next generation has continued unabated the through a World War, the birth and growing pains of the nation, through times of boom and bust, and social, political and technological change.

Over the years the ties between MCKK and MCOBA have been strengthened through initiatives like the "Old Boys Quota" under the Presidency Tan Sri Datuk Haji Mohd. Azmi bin Datuk Kamaruddin who served as President of MCOBA for 25 years. It was during his tenure that Bangunan MCOBA was built, funded by the generosity of the alumni. It was officially opened on the 3rd December 1977 by and DYMM Seri Paduka Baginda Yang Di Pertuan Agong, Tuanku Yahya Putra, an Old Boy of the school.

Under the leadership of Tunku Datuk Seri Adnan bin Tunku Besar Burhanuddin or Pak Engku as he is affectionately known, the Old Boys Association initiated the establishment of the MCOBA-OV Council (MCOV), which has been a step forward in enhancing the



long friendship between Malay College and Vajiravudh College. Since that time many a golf game and warm reminisces have been shared between Old Boys from both institutions.

MCOBA also enthusiastically participated in MCKK's centenary celebrations in 2005. Again, the Old Boys of MCKK made the town of Kuala Kangsar sit up and take notice as residents were treated to the grand spectacle of a reenactment of the First Durbar of the Malay Rulers complete with a procession of 7 elephants.

MCOBA has become more robust and active over the years, celebrating its 80th anniversary in 2009. The bonds between the Old Boys now extend into the corporate sector, recreation and social events like the Old Boys' Weekend, and the Annual Dinner which are fixtures on the MCOBA calendar. A key initiative in the past two years has been the creation of the MCKK archives, a massive undertaking which will collate, catalogue and store images and documents for research and reference purposes. The development of MCKK and the provision of work-related and social skills are a paramount consideration for MCOBA. As such, MCOBA has funded initiatives like the "Malay College InfoLab".

In keeping with the strong tradition of sporting excellence of MCKK, the All Blacks Revival (ABR) held the inaugural MCKK 7s Premier Rugby Tournament in honour of Dato' N.J. Ryan last year. The Tournament is perhaps the most ambitious part of the initiative to revive MCKK's rugby tradition, awakening a passion for the game among the current students of MCKK and claim the glory of being the best team in the country.

After 80 years MCOBA holds the distinction of being one of the oldest and most active alumni associations in existence. The loyalty and passion of its members runs deep bringing to mind the famous words of Aristotle: "The whole is greater than the sum of it's parts."







RULES OF THE TOURNAMENT

MCKK PREMIER 7'S 2012

Tournament Rules

1. Competition Format

- a. The tournament will be a twenty four (24) team event.
- b. The teams will be divided into eight (8) groups of three (3) teams each. c. Preliminary Round
 - i. Teams in the respective groups will play a round-robin format within their groups. Each team shall play two (2) matches against teams in their groups.
 - ii. If two (2) or more teams in the same group finish with the same number of points, the following shall determine the placing in the group.
 - iii. The team with the greater point difference (points for less points against) shall be declared the winner.
 - iv. If a decision is still not reached, then the total points derived through tries, goals and penalties by each team shall be considered, priority being given in that order. Hence the team that scored more of its points through tries shall be declared the winner over a team that scored less tries. If there should be a further tie, then the number of goals shall be considered and so on, in the stated order.
 - v. If a decision is still not reached, the qualifying order shall be determined by the drawing of lots.
 - vi. If any team gives a walkover in the Group matches, all their games will be deemed null and void. They will be placed 3rd in their group irrespective of the results of their other matches.

d. Quarter-Final Round

- i. The Top team in each group will advance to the Quarter-finals for the Cup and Plate pools. The teams will play as determined by the draw.
- ii. The Runner up in each group will proceed to the Quarter Finals for the Bowl pool. The teams will play as determined by the draw.
- iii. The Third Placed Team in each group will proceed to the Quarter -Finals for the Shield pool. The teams will play as determined by the draw.
- e. Semi-final Round
 - i. The winners of the Cup/Plate quarter-finals will advance to the semifinals of the CUP Championship.
 - ii. The losers of the Cup/Plate quarter-finals will proceed to the semifinals of the PLATE Championship.
 - iii. The winners of the Bowl quarter-finals will advance to the semi--finals of the BOWL Championship.
 - iv. The winners of the Shield quarter-finals will advance to the semifinals of the SHIELD Championship.
- v. The losers of BOTH the Bowl AND Shield quarter-finals are eliminated. f. Finals

Winners of all of the semi-finals will advance to the finals of their respective pools.

2. Registration

- a. All teams are to submit their Team Registration Form giving the final list of Twelve (12) players in their squad and their officials to the Tournament Director at the Manager's Meeting on the 24th February 2012.
- b. Teams/Schools are allowed to register only their currently registered students, born in 1995 or later as players.
- c. During the tournament, Team Managers must register their team playing list with the Tournament Director, at the Tournament Control Centre at the

field, no less than thirty (30) minutes before the commencement of their match.

- d. All Team Managers must personally register their team, with the full names of their players as in Rule 2 (c) above.
- e. Any late entries and proposed registration after the official registration deadline as in Rule 2 (c) will not be entertained, unless with prior consent of the Tournament Director.
- f. All teams must register a minimum of five (5) and a maximum of twelve (12) players upon submission of their team playing lists. No additional registration, transfer, replacement or change of team members will be permitted after the close of registration as in Rule 2 (c) above.
- g. In the event that, due to injuries, a team is unable to field a full complement of players derived from its own squad of twelve (12) registered players, such team may borrow no more than two (2) substitute players from any other team that has been eliminated from the Tournament. However, such players to be replaced have to be certified unfit to play by the Tournament Medical Officer.

A team that borrows a player or players must take the field with all their own available and uninjured players before using the replacement players. Such substitute players must be registered with the Tournament Director and can play subject to their new team using all their players first; these substitute players shall not be permitted to represent any other team during the remaining rounds of the Tournament.

3. Penalties

- a. Any team that plays with an unregistered player at any time during the Tournament shall forfeit their game.
- b. Any team that fields less than five (5) players in their scheduled game shall forfeit that game.

4. Reporting Times

- a. All teams must be at the field-side five (5) minutes before the scheduled kick-off of each of their games.
- b. Any team that does not field a complete team as in Rule (3) above, five
 (5) minutes after scheduled kick-off, will forfeit their game, provided their opposing team is on the field.
- c. If both opposing teams fail to report to the Referee on the field of play five (5) minutes after the scheduled kick-off, both teams will forfeit their game.
- d. All team captains / managers must register the names of their own seven (7) playing members for a game at the Tournament Control Centre thirty (30) minutes before commencement of the game. Additional registration forms are available from the Tournament Control Centre. It is the responsibility of Team Managers to ensure that teams obtain these forms.

5. Replacements

Rolling substitutions are allowed at any time during a game. Only three (3) substitute players are allowed for each game. The substitute player must report to the match official at the half way line and the player to be replaced must leave the field and report to the match official before the substitute player is released onto the field.

6. Playing Time

a. All matches except the finals shall be played in two (2) halves of seven
 (7) minutes each way with a one (1) minute interval between halves. The Finals will be played in two (2) halves of ten (10) minutes each way with

a two (2) minute interval between halves.

- b. Preliminary Round The preliminary round will be played on a roundrobin basis. The score will stand at the end of regulation time. There will be no extra time for matches ending in a draw.
- c. Quarter-final, Semi-final and Final Rounds.
 - All matches at these stages will be played on a knock-out basis. Should a match result in a draw at the end of regulation time, extra time will be played.
 - ii. Such extra time shall consist of periods of five (5) minutes "sudden death" play-off. There will be no break in between the periods and teams will change ends immediately. The team which first kicked-off the match will do so again in the "sudden death" extra-time.
 - iii. The "sudden-death" rule shall apply as follows. The first team to score during extra time will be declared the winner and the game will end.
 - iv. In the event of still no winner, "sudden death" penalty drop-kicks of up to three (3) kickers each team will be applied.
 - v. If a decision is still not reached, the winner shall be ultimately determined by the toss of coin.

7. Awarding of Points - Preliminary Round Points will be awarded as follows:

WIN - Two (2) Points DRAW - One (1) Point WALKOVER - Two (2) Points LOSS - Zero (0) Points

8. Official Playing Rules

The Tournament By-Laws are based on the International Rugby Board (IRB) By-Laws with seven-a-side variations of the game as adopted by the Malaysian Rugby Union. These by-laws will apply throughout the tournament, except the following:-

The number of players in the team will be seven (7). The number of players required in a scrum is three (3)

Sin Bin: If a player is sent to the "Sin - Bin" by the referee he must proceed immediately to the designated position at the Referees' Control Stand. He must remain stationary there for a period of three (3) mins. Only when present at the Referees' Control Stand will the period of three (3) minutes commence. Only the referee may authorise a return to play after a "Sin - Bin" period and only at the next stoppage.

9. Technical Zone Protocol

The Technical Zone Protocol as introduced by the IRB in May 2006 will be implemented during this Tournament.

- During a game, other than the team's registered players, each participating team is allowed four (4) representatives including two (2) water carriers operating from their Technical Zone.
- No additional people are allowed in the Technical Zone.
- The medical personnel in the Technical Zone may enter the field of play in accordance with Law at any time a player is injured.
- Water carriers may only take water onto the field during stoppages in play for injuries in the playing area and when a try has been scored and at no other times.
- Water carriers must remain in the Technical Zone except when providing water as detailed above.
- Water bottles must not be thrown onto the field.

- All personnel in the Technical Zone must wear a bib / vest for identification purposes and must not wear a shirt similar in colour to their team.
- The fourth official will manage the Technical Zone and will report any indiscretion to the match referee. The match referee may caution the offender or expel them from the playing enclosure. Any offender may be reported to the Disciplinary Committee for investigation and further action.
- Replacement players and all other team officials other than those in the Technical Zone must remain seated on the replacement bench.
- Replacement players are only allowed to warm up before they enter the field in a designated place set further back from the field of play than the replacement bench.

10. "Home" & "Away" Teams

These terms are used in a game should there be a clash of jersey colours. In this situation, the "Home" team shall have to change its jerseys to a set of acceptable colour.

11. Protests

All protests must be submitted in writing through Team Managers to the Tournament Director within thirty (30) minutes of the end of the game during which the matter of the protest occurred. Verbal protests will not be entertained. A protest must be submitted together with a deposit of RM100. The deposit will be returned if the protest is upheld. Should the protest be overruled, the deposit will be forfeited.

12. Appeal & Disciplinary Committee

- a. This Committee shall hear all appeals and decide on disciplinary action for the duration of the Tournament. The Tournament Director shall be coopted at any hearing of the Committee but shall have no vote.
- b. Players or Team Officials reported for misconduct or sent off the field shall have their cases considered as soon as possible by the Committee.
- c. Any player who is sent off the field shall be automatically suspended for one (1) game and the Committee shall determine his further participation in the Tournament.
- d. Any player that receives more than one (1) Yellow card in the Tournament shall be automatically suspended for the subsequent game. The Committee shall determine his further participation in the tournament.
- e. The quorum for the meeting of this Committee shall be three (3) members. Disciplinary action taken by the Committee shall only apply for the duration of the Tournament. The Committee shall report the actions taken to relevant bodies for any further review.

13. Interpretation of Tournament Rules

The Organising Committee reserves the right of interpretation in the case of doubts arising from the wording of any rule. It shall also have the right to decide on any situation that is not covered by the rules and such decision shall be final.

14. Trophy Ownership and Responsibility

- a. The NJ Ryan Trophy (Tournament Trophy) remains the property of MCKK/ MCOBA and cannot be won outright.
- b. The winning team shall receive the Trophy and a replica, but will have to return the Trophy to the Organising Committee before they depart for home.






