

TOURNAMENT SUMMARY



The 3rd edition of the MCKK Premier 7s Rugby Tournament was held on the 22nd to 24th February 2013 at the MCKK rugby grounds. The tournament saw 24 teams – including those from Singapore, Brunei, Hong Kong and Thailand – compete during the three day event which started on Friday.

The organisers again managed to organise the tournament with success, with the participating teams displaying the highest quality of schools rugby 7s thus reaffirming the tournament as the premier and benchmarking schools' rugby event for the country.

Host Malay College Kuala Kangsar (MCKK) All Blacks ended Tunku Mahkota Ismail Sports School's (SSTMI) reign to steal the coveted NJ Ryan Trophy to win the MCKK 7s Premier rugby tournament. MCKK All Blacks prevailed over Selangor state champion, SMS Hulu Selangor (SEMASHUR) 19-7 to win the title for

the first time. The Man of The Match Award was presented to MCKK's Mohd Shahmi Abdul Shukor. The NJ Ryan Trophy was presented by DYAM Raja DiHilir Perak, Raja Jaafar Raja Muda Musa.

SSTMI's two-year domination (2011 and 2012) came to a halt after failing to reach the Cup quarterfinals in the biggest upset of the tournament. SMKA Sheikh Othman Abdul Wahab (SHOAW), the 2012 Cup finalist, suffered the same fate as SSTMI.

International newcomer Hong Kong Sports School (HKSS) dominated in the Plate category to hammer SMK Sultan Yahya Petra 1 (SSYP1) to win 46-12. MCOBA President Tan Sri Megat Najmuddin bin Dato Seri Dr. Hj. Megat Khas presented the prizes to the winners in this category.

Nonetheless, SSTMI found redemption to emerge victorious in the Bowl category after they down

Tunku Abdul Rahman School (STAR) 33-28 in sudden death.

SMK King George V (KGV) won the Shield competition in a tight contest against Putrajaya's Sultan Alam Shah School (SAS), 15-12.

The 3rd edition of the MCKK Premier 7s Rugby Tournament was a success, providing truly exciting weekend of rugby of the highest school standard for every one present.
